Date set for next World Championships

The reason for this is if held in 2012 when the Olympics would be running, it would be hard for all country's to find sponsorship and press coverage as the Olympics would take president over our own world championships.

Minutes taken for European

Motion carried for next European Championships to be held 2010

After a discussion on how last world championships was financed, it was pointed out that it takes €4,000 per a day to run TSN Milano. From this it was decided by all members present that the cost of a European championships has to be financed via entry fees paid up front and by sponsorship. End of registration date to be set.

Location of 2010 European Championships.

Only two country's at present are able to hold the next European Championships which are Germany and Italy, all other countries do not have the structure in place at present to hold such an event. If Czech Republic get help from its own then they maybe able to put an offer in.

It was said that a championship needs to have a team of people working together to produce the next championships and that the event manager just manages the individual team.

Rule Book

With a discussion with all delegates except Germany not present, it was decided that the rule book needs to be looked at and to be unified. It was to decided by all present that the rule book would be called simply Rimfire Rules. New changes need be talked about and have to be voted on by all countries before going ahead. But it was decided to wait to see what comes from the WBC Rules before going any further.

Targets

With a discussion with all delegates except Germany not present it was decide that the 25yd would be stay the same but maybe more sighters would be added. And that it would a stay as A3 size this would be done at a later date and to be decided.

Other business

- Hunter class needs to be talked about at some point and voted on.
- All team captains to represent each country.
- ERABSF president was declared as Carlo Caricato by all representatives present except Germany.
